FRIDAY, JUNE 7: WELCOME TO WASHINGTON DC!

Late morning or early afternoon arrival into Washington-Dulles International Airport; transfer to hotel for check-in

5:00P Welcome dinner

6:30P-9:30P Our first rehearsal together as a mass choir!

SATURDAY, JUNE 8: WASHINGTON DC

After breakfast, we'll continue our rehearsing. Afterwards, we'll board our coaches for a guided tour of our nation's capitol driving past the White House, the Washington Monument, and the US Capitol Building. We'll have stops at Arlington Memorial Cemetery, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Lincoln Memorial,



Jefferson Memorial, and the Vietnam War Veterans Memorial. You'll have time for lunch on your own at the historic Old Post Office—a building completed in 1899, at the time it was the largest government building in DC and the first clock tower. After narrowly escaping demolition in 1934 and again in the 1960's, it now hosts a variety of fast food and sit-down meal restaurants, some shops, and an observation tower. After lunch, we stop at the beautiful Washington National Cathedral for a visit. This Gothic cathedral is the 6th largest in the world and was completed in 1990 after 83 years of construction! This afternoon we will have a moving visit of the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum. Free tonight for dinner on your own or perhaps take in a concert or play at the Kennedy Center or other DC venue.



SUNDAY, JUNE 9: WORSHIP IN WASHINGTON!

This morning after breakfast you have the option to worship in a local church of your choice. After lunch (on your own), we will depart the hotel for the historic Constitution Hall for dress rehearsal and to prepare for tonight's concert. Constitution Hall was built in 1929 by the Daughters of the American Revolution to house their annual convention. The cornerstone was laid by Mrs. Calvin Coolidge on October 30, 1928 using the very trowel George Washington used to lay the cornerstone at the Capital in 1793! It

is still owned and operated by the National Society of Daughters of the American Revolution and was designated a National Historic Landmark in 1985. **WORSHIP IN WASHINGTON tonight with special guest recording artists, Travis Cottrell and Charles Billingsley!**
